



PHYSICAL AND HEALTH EDUCATION COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP PLACEMENT

Placement Role: Physiotherapy Clinic Assistant

Host Organization: Martel and Mitchell Physiotherapy

Placement Service Times: Students to interview with host to discuss availability. To be negotiated with host based on the student academic schedule. Weekday, evening and weekend hours may be required.

Host Description: Martel & Mitchell Physiotherapy provides a comprehensive range of orthopedic rehabilitation services in a professional, caring and healthy environment. With clinics in North Bay, Powassan, and Mattawa, they provide exceptional personal, local health care.

Placement Duties: The placement student will spend a minimum of 50 hours training under the supervision of a Registered Physiotherapist and/or Registered Kinesiologist. A variety of treatment modalities will be explored in a clinical setting.

Placement students will:

- Observe orthopedic assessment including musculoskeletal and postural evaluations
- Observe and assist the PT in the provision of treatment of orthopedic injuries
- Observe musculoskeletal and posture evaluations
- Observe and assist in the maintenance of complete and accurate documents of all assessments, treatments, and rehabilitation plans clinic patients in a confidential manner and in accordance with the Health Information Protection Act and the Standards of the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario
- Advise the supervisor regarding maintenance of inventory, ordering all medical supplies for medical kits and clinic supplies
- Perform daily cleaning and maintenance of treatment room, including laundry and cleaning treatment tables

Placement Requirements: This placement is available to students who have already successfully completed PHED 3106, and plan to apply to graduate studies in physiotherapy within one calendar year. Placement students must be flexible, able to work independently and available during business hours. Valid police check, CPR Level C/FA. For all clinical placements, an up to date immunization record must be available upon request. **Students applying for this placement must submit in hardcopy to the placement office: a resume, cover letter and be willing to interview for the limited number of positions available.**

Number of Students Accommodated within placement: (minimum 50 hours): 1 per academic year
