

## PHYSICAL AND HEALTH EDUCATION COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP PLACEMENT

Placement Role: Health Team Assistant - Clinic Health Promoter and Dietician Team

Host Organization: Blue Sky Family Health Team, 685 Bloem Street, North Bay.

**Placement Service Times**: Students to interview with host to discuss availability. To be negotiated with host based on the student academic schedule. Weekday, evening and weekend hours may be required.

Host Description: Family Health Teams are health care organizations that include a team of family physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, social workers, dietitians, and other professionals who work together to provide health care for their community. Family Health Teams provide more service and a wide range of health options, especially for people who don't have a doctor. Family Health Teams ensure that people receive the care they need in their communities, as each team is set-up based on local health and community needs. They focus on chronic disease management, disease prevention and health promotion, and work with other health care organizations, such as public health units and Community Care Access Centres.

**Placement Duties**: The placement student will spend a minimum of 50 hours training under the supervision of a Clinic Health Promoter and/or Registered Dieticians. A variety of assessments and programs will be explored in a clinical setting.

Placement Requirements: This placement is available to students who have already successfully completed PHED 3106, and plan to pursue clinical and/or health promotion related industries. Placement students must be flexible, able to work independently and available during business hours. Valid police check, CPR Level C/FA. For all clinical placements, an up to date immunization record must be available upon request. Students selected for this placement must submit a resume, cover letter and be willing to interview for the limited number of positions available.
