



PHYSICAL AND HEALTH EDUCATION COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP PLACEMENT

Host Organization: Chippewa Intermediate and Secondary School

Placement Role: Head Basketball coach – junior girls.

Dates: Student must be available to lead basketball practices. Practices are normally Mon/Wed and Fri (if desired) at 3:30 or 5:30 (sometimes 6:30). Game days are Tuesdays and Thursdays at 4:30 or 6:00. Students are expected to be available during practice and game days. League play begins September 17th and concludes mid to late November. Students to interview with host to discuss availability. Competition schedule to be confirmed.

Placement Duties: The placement student will spend a minimum of 50 hours coaching high school level athletes under the supervision of the head coach. Placement students will:

Duties

- Prepare practice and game programming suitable for high school athletes at junior level.
- Prepare practice plans and drills
- Lead warm up activities
- Additional duties as required.
- Thorough understanding of sport specific safety guidelines as expressed by OPHEA

Placement Requirements: Placement students must be flexible, able to work independently. Interest in continuing studies in coaching and education recommended but not required. Valid police check and CPR Level C/FA required. Successful completion of PHED Basketball I practical required. Successful completion of Coaching, NCCP Intro to Competition preferred. Students must submit via email to the host; a resume including cover letter to the placement office indicating their coaching goals. Qualified students should prepare to be interviewed for the limited number of positions available.
